A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF NEW MACLAND ROAD, AND AFFECTED SIDE STREETS, FROM MACEDONIA ROAD TO THE CITY'S NORTHERN BOUNDARY LIMITS TO ACCOMMODATE THE MCEACHERN HIGH SCHOOL HOMECOMING PARADE ON OCTOBER 2, 2024; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY TRAFFIC CONTROL BY THE POLICE AND PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS McEachern High School has submitted an application to hold its homecoming parade on October 2, 2024 from 5:00 PM to 6:30 PM beginning at the intersection of Macedonia Road and New Macland Road and terminating at McEachern High School; and


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs desires to accommodate the requested road closure in furtherance of its strategic priority of creating an atmosphere of community.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the closure of New Macland Road and Macedonia Roads beginning at the intersection of New Macland Road and Macedonia Road, including affected side streets, and continuing into the unincorporated area of Cobb County just south of Glenn Road from 5:00 PM to 6:30 PM on October 2, 2024 in order to accommodate the McEachern High School homecoming parade.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Police and Public Works Departments are authorized to take necessary action to provide appropriate traffic control along the affected roadways.






