AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FROM THE UNRESTRICTED RESERVE FUND TO THE BUDGETS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, FINANCE DEPARTMENT, PARKS DEPARTMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS DEPARMENT WATER DIVISION; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs have determined that circumstances warrant a change in the existing budget ordinance for fiscal year 2019 to amend certain departmental budgets for retention and staffing and for certain landscape installation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council desire to transfer funds from the unrestricted reserve funds to the police, finance, parks, and public works department budgets;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the fiscal year 2019 be amended as provided in the attached Schedule A;

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon execution by the Mayor and City Council.
