RESOLUTION 2025 - 008

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CERTAIN STATEWIDE MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH COBB COUNTY AND THE GEORGIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND HOMELAND SECURITY AGENCY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the State of Georgia is vulnerable to a wide range of natural and man-made disasters and emergencies; and

WHEREAS the Georgia Emergency Management Act, as amended (The Act) gives the local governments of the State the authority to make agreements for mutual aid assistance in emergencies; and

WHEREAS pre-existing agreements for mutual aid assistance in emergencies help to ensure the timely provision of mutual aid assistance and the reimbursement of costs incurred by those parties who render such assistance; and

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") finds it in the public interest to establish a framework to support mutual assistance in responding to and managing an emergency or disaster.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that the form of the mutual aid agreement, attached as Exhibit A, is approved, and the Mayor is authorized to execute a mutual aid agreement, in form substantially similar to Exhibit A, after review and approval by the City Attorney.
