
A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH MICHELE COURSEY WHO IS LEAVING EMPLOYMENT BUT HAS AGREED AND IS ABLE TO PROVIDE CERTAIN MUNICIPAL SERVICES DURING A TEMPORARY PERIOD OF TRANSITION FOR A FEE RELATED TO THE SERVICES OR PROJECT PROVIDED; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS from time-to-time employees whose services are needed leave employment with the City of Powder Springs ("City") but are willing and able to provide certain continued services or tasks until their role has been filled, responsibilities are absorbed by other personnel or other arrangement secured; and


WHEREAS the City finds it in the best interest of the City to authorize the City Manager, Finance Director and Organizational Development Director collectively, or their designees, to identify the necessary and essential services or tasks the departing employee is willing and able to perform as well as the project or task fee or hourly rate that will apply to said service; and

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the mayor to execute an agreement for a period of up to six months with Michele Coursey who is leaving employment but has agreed and is able to provide certain municipal services during a period of transition as determined by the City Manager, Finance Director and Organizational Development Director, or their designees, subject to review and approval by the City attorney and budget availability.




