

## Resolution No. 2021 - 138

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH QUADIENT, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000 FOR POSTAGE METER AND SERVICES; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs previously approved a lease agreement with Neopost, Inc., subsequently purchased by Quadient, Inc., for a postage meter and services; and


**WHEREAS**, quotes were solicited and obtained and the City desires to accept the recommendation to approve a lease with Quadient, Inc. for five one-year terms as the lowest responsive bidder;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the lease agreement with Quadient, Inc. for a postage meter and services is approved for five one-year terms at an annual cost not to exceed \$10,000.00, subject to inclusion of shipping and installation of a new machine, training, maintenance, meter rental and certified mail set up, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement with Quadient, Inc. subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption with said term of lease to begin at expiration of current lease in November 2021






