A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH KECK AND WOOD FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATED TO CURB CUTS ON CH JAMES PARKWAY/US 278 FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$24,000; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") budgeted funds in the capital budget for engineering work relating to curb cut improvements on CH James Parkway/US 278, which was identified in the Comprehensive Plan as a continued need of the City;

WHEREAS, the City desires to engage its Comprehensive Plan transportation consultant, Keck and Wood, to assist in developing plans to achieve curb cuts at strategic locations on CH James Parkway that had been previously initiated by the City and tentatively approved by the Georgia Department of Transportation; and

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Keck and Wood for professional engineering services to facilitate curb cuts at strategic locations on CH James Parkway, including near the intersection of Lewis Road and Oglesby, Sweetwater Landing and locations identified in the Comprehensive Plan. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
