

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-032 *6/er*

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH TUNNELL-SPANGLER WALSH & ASSOCIATES d/b/a TSW FOR PROFESSIONAL DESIGN AND ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE DOWNTOWN PUBLIC PARK AMENITY FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$428,065.00; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") previously engaged the firm Tunnell Spangler Walsh & Associates d/b/a TSW to update the City's Livable Centers Initiative ("LCI") plan in 2015;

WHEREAS, TSW completed the LCI Plan update in 2016, recommending the development of a downtown public park amenity, said plan being adopted by the City in 2016;


WHEREAS, thereafter TSW was engaged by the Downtown Development Authority to prepare preliminary engineered plans and design concepts for the downtown public park amenity, draft options of which were completed and submitted to public review in December 2017;

WHEREAS, the public selected the preferred layout and features for the public park amenity at the January 2018 Town Hall meeting, and the City desires to engage TSW and TSW is willing and able to complete engineered plans for the park and features as selected by the public;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract with TSW to provide professional services for design, engineering, bid support and management and construction oversight as described in its proposal for an amount of \$428,065.00, subject to review and approval of the City attorney.





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
