A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT APPLICATIONS FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE CITY IN RESPONSE TO RISKS CREATED BY THE COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") has incurred and will continue to incur expenses related to the City's response to risks created by the novel coronavirus ("COVID-19");






