RESOLUTION NO. 2025 - 125

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH HOLIDAY DESIGNS FOR THE PURCHASE OF 72 HOLIDAY POLE MOUNTS FOR A SUM OF \$39,828 AS PART OF A DISCOUNT CHRISTMAS IN JULY SALE; AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION AND STORAGE OF SAID ITEMS SUBJECT TO THE REMAINING BUDGETED DOLLARS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") has previously engaged the services of Jensen Industries, LLC d/b/a Twelve 25 Lighting to install, remove and store the City's tower Christmas Tree, lighting, decorations, garlands, ornaments on the tower tree, Marietta Street pole displays, street banner and sleigh ("Christmas decorations and supplies") to be displayed in Thurman Springs Park and the Marietta Street corridor FOR THE 2025-2025 holiday season; and

WHEREAS in October, the city will schedule and pay the deposit to secure installation the week before Thanksgiving and removal and storage of said existing items by mid-January; and

WHEREAS the City subsequently requested and budgeted for additional pole mounts to expand the scope of installation to a wider area consistent with the attached locations and map for an amount of \$58,680; and

WHEREAS Holiday Designs conducted a discount Christmas in July sale to provide pole mounts for a fee of \$39,828, and the city desires to accept and approve the purchase and savings.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the mayor to execute an agreement with Holiday Designs to purchase 72 pole mounts for a sum of \$39,828, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED staff is directed to solicit and approve the cost to install and store the holiday pole mounts, anticipated to be approximately \$13,000.00, subject to the remaining budget dollars.
