A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE COBB COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AGREEMENT FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2017; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID AMENDMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs' (the "City") previously approved the Cobb County Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Subrecipient Agreement for Program Year 2017, CD17-C17C8 ("2017 CDBG Agreement"), for improvements at the Silver Comet Trail Linear Park for an amount of \$52,696.46;
