AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE EQUITABLE SHARING ACCOUNT TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY BUDGET FOR THE PURCHASE OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR AND FROM THE SPECIAL PURPOSE LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX PROGRAM FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") previously authorized the purchase of automated external defibrillators ("AED's") and police department vehicles using funds from the equitable sharing account and the special purpose local option sales tax ("SPLOST") program account;

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the budget to allocate equitable sharing funds and SPLOST to the city police department budget for AED's and police vehicles respectively:

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the fiscal year 2019 be amended as provided in the attached;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon execution by the Mayor and City Council.
