A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH GEORGIA POWER COMPANY FOR THE PROVISION OF PEDESTRIAN LED STREET LIGHTING ALONG JACKSON WAY EXTENSION, PINEVIEW AND MARIETTA STREET FOR THE INSTALLATION AMOUNT OF \$56,500.00 AND A MONTHLY SERVICE FEE OF \$240.24; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs is vested with the legal authority to provide lighting to the streets within its municipal street system; and

WHEREAS the City currently has need for pedestrian street lighting along Jackson Way Extension, Pineview Drive and Marietta Street; and

WHEREAS the Georgia Power Company is willing and able to provide such lighting by way of the installation of eleven (11) LED lights at a cost of \$56,500 and a monthly service charge of \$240.24.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that an agreement with Georgia Power Company for the provision of pedestrian street lighting is hereby approved and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement effectuating same after review and approval by the City Attorney.
