

RESOLUTION 2026 - 062

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE ATTACHED LIST OF PROJECTS FOR INCLUSION ON A REFERENDUM BY COBB COUNTY FOR THE 2028 RENEWAL OF THE 2022 SPECIAL PURPOSE LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE USE AND DISTRIBUTION OF PROCEEDS FROM ANY RENEWAL THAT MAY BE APPROVED TO FUND THE CITY'S CAPITAL PROJECTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS a county-wide special purpose local option sales tax is currently being imposed in Cobb County and funding capital outlay projects for the county governing authority and the governing authorities of the municipalities within Cobb County, including the City of Powder Springs (the "2022 SPLOST") and

WHEREAS the 2022 SPLOST is set to expire at the end of Calendar Year 2027, and representatives of the City of Powder Springs ("City") have met with representatives of Cobb County and the other municipalities within Cobb County to discuss potential projects to be included in a referendum to be brought before voters on November 3, 2026 to renew the 2022 SPLOST; and

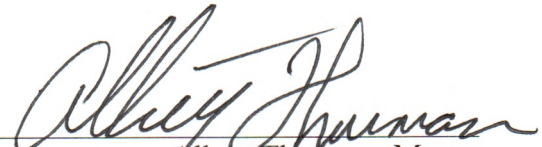
WHEREAS the City has future, planned capital outlay projects it would fund if the current SPLOST were renewed for an additional term beginning January 1, 2028 and the City desires to submit its list of projects to the county for inclusion in the November 3, 2026 referendum; and

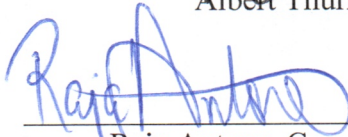
WHEREAS, if a referendum is presented to the voters to renew the SPLOST program, the City will also be required to enter into a new Intergovernmental Agreement for the Use and Distribution of Proceeds to implement the City's capital project list.

NOW THEREFORE, it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the submittal of the City's list of projects attached hereto as Exhibit A for inclusion in the November 3, 2026 referendum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with Cobb County for the Use and Distribution of SPLOST Proceeds, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
