

RESOLUTION 2026 - 019

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THURMAN SPRINGS PARK FOR A FITNESS AND WELLNESS EXPO ON MARCH 21 2026 FROM 10AM-2PM; AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS IN THE DOWNTOWN TO ACCOMMODATE THE EVENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS The Fitness & Wellness Expo at Thurman Springs Park is a community-driven outdoor event bringing together families, athletes, fitness enthusiasts, and wellness partners for a full day of movement, education, and connection in Powder Springs; and

WHEREAS the application was submitted by D1 Training West Cobb to conduct an active fitness event where other local and regional fitness organizations, gyms, trainers, and studios can participate; and

WHEREAS Attendees will experience rotating fitness sessions for all ages and levels, including youth athletic development, speed and agility, adult functional fitness, strength, recovery, and mobility; and


WHEREAS The Expo also features health, fitness, and medical vendors, hands-on wellness activations, and a family-friendly Kids Activity Zone designed to keep young athletes moving and engaged.


WHEREAS the city desires to approve the temporary event permit to use Thurman Springs Park for a wellness activity to support its strategic priority of creating destinations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves the temporary use of Thurman Springs Park on March 21, 2026 from 10am-2pm for a wellness expo, on the condition that the applicant provides all security and sanitation services required by the police and sanitation departments and notifies all downtown businesses about said event immediately upon approval of this resolution.

SO RESOLVED AND EFFECTIVE this 2nd day of February 2026.




