

**RESOLUTION 2021 – 034**

**A RESOLUTION ABANDONING A SECTION OF THE MUNICIPAL STREET SYSTEM BEING KNOWN AS A PORTION OF OLD LOST MOUNTAIN ROAD, A/K/A JACKSON WAY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS,** the City of Powder Springs (“the City”) owns and maintains a municipal street system; and

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to the provisions of The Official Code of Georgia Annotated § 32-7-2 (c), when the City determines that a section of the municipal street system has for any reason ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it or that its removal from the municipal street system is otherwise in the best public interest, the City, by certification recorded in its minutes, accompanied by a plat or sketch, and after notice to property owners located thereon, may declare that section of the municipal street system abandoned; and


**WHEREAS,** that section of Old Lost Mountain Road, a/k/a Jackson Way, as it currently exists lying between 4494 Marietta Street (Cobb County Tax Parcel 19087600050) and 4484 Marietta Street (Cobb County Tax Parcel 19087500300) has ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it and its removal from the municipal street system is in the best public interest; and

**WHEREAS,** the Powder Springs Downtown Development Authority is or will soon be the owner of both properties fronting said section of the municipal street system and is award of the proposed abandonment.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the section of Old Lost Mountain Road, a/k/a Jackson Way, as it currently exists lying between 4494 Marietta Street (Cobb County Tax Parcel 19087600050) and 4484 Marietta Street (Cobb County Tax Parcel 19087500300) has ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it, its removal from the municipal street system is in the best public interest, and it is hereby declared abandoned. This Resolution shall serve as the required Certification of Abandonment with a plat of the abandoned area attached hereto and incorporated herein by way of reference as Exhibit “A” to be recorded in the City’s official minutes. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


