
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH WHAT'S POPPIN' GOURMET POPCORN AND SWEET TREATS TO PROVIDE CERTAIN CONCESSION SERVICES AT THE SILVER COMET TRAIL LINEAR PARK PAVILION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") previously executed an agreement with What's Poppin' Gourmet Popcorn and Sweet Treats (hereinafter "What's Poppin'") to provide concession services at the Silver Comet Trail Linear Park pavilion;


WHEREAS, the City desires to renew an agreement for (2) years with What's Poppin' to continue concession services at the Silver Comet Trail Linear Park with an amendment to increase the contractor's distribution to the City from 10% to 12% of receipts for Year (1) and 12% to 15% of receipts for Year (2); and

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute a renewal agreement with What's Poppin' Gourmet Popcorn and Sweet Treats, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. The resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.
