A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY USE AND CLOSURE OF THURMAN SPRINGS PARK AND SURROUNDING ROADS ON OCTOBER 19, OCTOBER 26 OR NOVEMBER 2 FROM 4PM TO 7PM TO ACCOMMODATE A TEMPORARY EVENT HOSTED BY CENTER FOR COMMON GROUND; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") has received an application for a temporary event permit from Center for Common Ground to host an educational event regarding voter registration and early voting at Thurman Springs Park on October 19, or October 26, or November 2, 2024, from 4PM to 7PM, that will require the temporary use and closure the park and certain roads around the park; and

WHEREAS the City finds it in the public interest to authorize the use and closure of certain public spaces in the downtown to accommodate the proposed educational event.
