**Project:** Stormwater repairs Work Order approval

**Recommendation:** Staff recommends approving the following Work Orders to on-call contractors to make high-priority repairs to stormwater infrastructure in various locations in the city using American Rescue Plan Act grant funds:

**Background:** The Mayor and Council chose to direct a portion of the funds from the City's ARPA grant to address stormwater infrastructure needs throughout the City. Using the Lowe assessment staff has identified a number of repairs needed to correct failures or deteriorated assets. The projects covered by these Work Orders are of high-priority, with failed or failing pipes and/or structures.

Using the on-call stormwater repair contracts Council awarded in June, staff identified the contractors with the lowest cost for each repair based on the unit prices in their contracts. These contractors then responded with the recommended Work Orders. Staff has issued additional Work Orders to the on-call vendors and expect to bring these to City Council in the near future.

**Summary:** The cost of the proposed projects in these Work Orders totals \$827,470.20. The recently amended ARPA Project Budget has remaining to be spent \$785,766 for stormwater repairs.
