**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH COLUMBITECH TO PROVIDE SECURE AND UNINTERRUPTED WIRELESS DATA PROTECTION FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") previously approved an agreement with Columbitech, Inc. ("Columbitech") to provide wireless data protection for the Police Department's laptops and other mobile devices;

**WHEREAS**, the Columbitech standards-based software mobile virtual private network (mobile VPN) enables organizations to protect wireless data traffic, provide secure and uninterrupted access to public safety records from laptops and other mobile devices;

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to renew its agreement with Columbitech in order to enable public safety personnel to move between wired and wireless networks without interruption;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and authorizes the Mayor to execute a renewal agreement with Columbitech after review and approval by the City Attorney.






