AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 TO RECOGNIZE AND ALLOCATE REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES RELATING TO FEDERAL SEIZURE DOLLARS, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESURFACING AND INSURANCE PROCEEDS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") desires to amend the Fiscal Year 2021 budget to recognize and allocate revenues and expenditures relating to federal seizure dollars, emergency preparedness and resurfacing set-asides and insurance proceeds;

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the Fiscal Year 2021 be amended as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A".

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon execution by the Mayor and City Council.






