

RESOLUTION NO. 2023 - 027

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF PARK FURNITURE AND ACCESSORIES FOR PLACEMENT IN POWDER SPRINGS PARK PAVILIONS FOR A SUM OF \$44,443 UNDER THE SPECIAL PURPOSE LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR SAID PURCHASE IF NEEDED; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs (the “City”) has completed the first phase of recreational improvements in Powder Springs Park under the Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (“SPLOST”) program for the benefit of City residents and visitors;


**WHEREAS**, the City desires to furnish the constructed pavilions with seating and trash receptacles and requested the project contractor to provide an estimate for said fixtures, to include game tables and accessibility seating;


**WHEREAS**, the contractor provided an estimate for purchase, delivery and installation of 24 requested tables and 8 trash receptacles and the City finds it in the best interest of the public to proceed.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the purchase, delivery and installation of outdoor tables and trash receptacles for the pavilions at Powder Springs Park for a sum of \$44,443 is hereby approved and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement for said purchase, if needed, subject to review and approval of the City Attorney. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




