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**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 TO RECOGNIZE 2021 LOCAL MAINTENANCE IMPROVEMENT GRANT FUNDS; TO RECOGNIZE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS; TO RECOGNIZE AND ALLOCATE DEVELOPER PAVING FEES FOR PAVING WITHIN VINEYARDS SUBDIVISION; TO RE-BUDGET FUNDS FROM FISCAL YEAR 2020 EXPENDED FOR EVENTS THAT WERE POSTPONED TO FISCAL YEAR 2021; TO RECOGNIZE ADDITIONAL REVENUES FROM THE SPECIAL PURPOSE LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX (SPLOST) PROGRAM; TO INCREASE SPLOST EXPENDITURES FOR PROJECT CONSTRUCTION OVERSIGHT; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

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**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs ("City") desires to amend the Fiscal Year 2021 budget to recognize and allocate revenues and expenditures relating to the Local Maintenance Improvement Grant ("LMIG") program for resurfacing, the Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") program for personal protective equipment, developer paving fees for certain resurfacing and the Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax ("SPLOST") relating to construction oversight and resurfacing.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the Fiscal Year 2021 be amended as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A".

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon execution by the Mayor and City Council.
