

RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 128


A RESOLUTION DECLARING AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF FURNITURE, FIXTURES AND EQUIPMENT REMOVED FROM THE OLD CITY HALL, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND MUNICIPAL COURT FACILITIES AND CURRENTLY LOCATED IN STORAGE, INCLUDING THROUGH AUCTION, YARD SALE, SAME-DAY-REMOVAL OR SIMILAR MEANS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (“City”) has previously declared as surplus and authorized for disposition the furniture, fixtures and equipment removed from the old city hall, community development and municipal court facilities that are currently located in storage and will no longer be used, including items such as kitchen tables and chairs, conference tables and chairs, offices desks and chairs, and reception area furniture; and


WHEREAS the City has attempted to sell said property on platforms such as GovDeals without any success, and the City thus finds it in its best interest to authorize the sale or disposition of said property through auction, yard sale, same day removal or similar means.


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council that it hereby reaffirms its declaration of surplus of the furniture, fixtures and equipment previously removed from city facilities and currently located in storage and authorizes its sale or disposal in accordance with governing laws, including through auction, yard sale, same day removal or similar means and it further authorizes the mayor to execute any documentation necessary to effectuate the sale, disposal or auction of said property.






