**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN DOWNTOWN POWDER SPRINGS TO ACCOMMODATE NATIONAL NIGHT OUT ON OCTOBER 4 AND THE ANNUAL PARADE AND TREE LIGHTING ON DECEMBER 2, 2022; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


**WHEREAS** the City of Powder Springs (the "City") will host a number of events and concerts during calendar year 2022; and


**WHEREAS** the events and concerts will require the temporary closure of downtown roads and public spaces to accommodate event activities and pedestrian safety;


**WHEREAS** the City previously authorized the temporary closure of various roads to accommodate city events scheduled for calendar year 2022 by Resolution 2022-022 but inadvertently excluded National Night Out on October 4 and the annual tree lighting and parade on December 2, 2022;


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the temporary closure and use of downtown roads and public spaces is hereby approved to accommodate National Night Out on October 4, 2022 from noon to 11:00PM and the annual Tree Lighting and Parade on December 2, 2022 from 3:00PM to 10:00PM. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




