



City of Powder Springs
USATF Certified 5K course
(With 10K option)

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Overview

This is a proposal to measure and certify a 5K (kilometers or 3.11 mile) course for the City of Powder Springs, GA with an option to also measure and certify a 10K (6.21 mile) course as well.

Deliverables

1. Measure the course(s) with a USATF calibrated analog measurer.
2. Map the course with Start and Finish lines triangulated along with GPS coordinates.
3. Review course for edits, additions, or amendments.
4. Submit course for State, Regional, and National USATF certification (now lasting 10 years).

Pricing

The price to measure and certify the 5k Course is \$350

The price to measure and certify the 10k course is \$400

The price to measure and certify both the 5k and 10k course is \$650

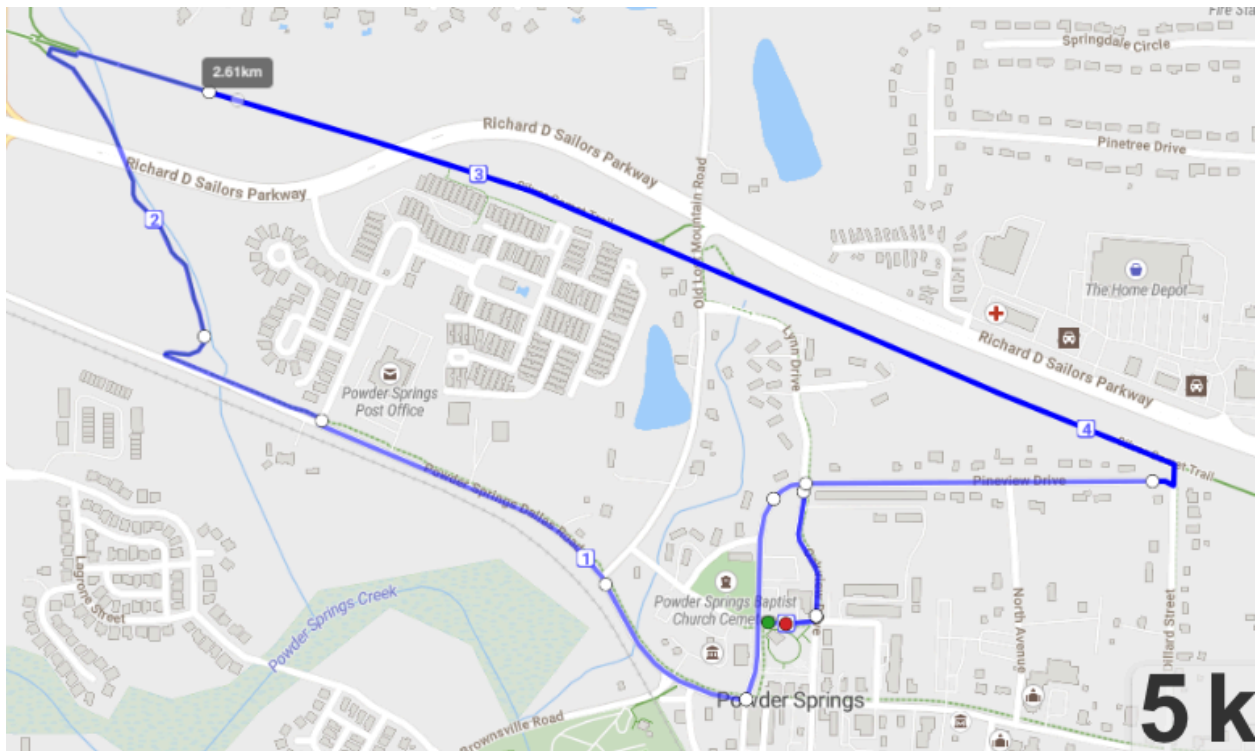
This fee covers the services of measurement, review, edits, and application. This service is based on the assumption that all course measurements and markings will be completed in one day. If an additional day(s) or partial day onsite is required after the initial measurement is completed, the final bill will be adjusted by \$80 for each additional partial day and \$150 for each full day.

No Deposit is needed but all services will be paid in full when a certification number has been assigned to the course(s).

Course(s)

The final course will be reviewed again by all necessary parties before measurements begin to ensure correct and accurate certifications occur.

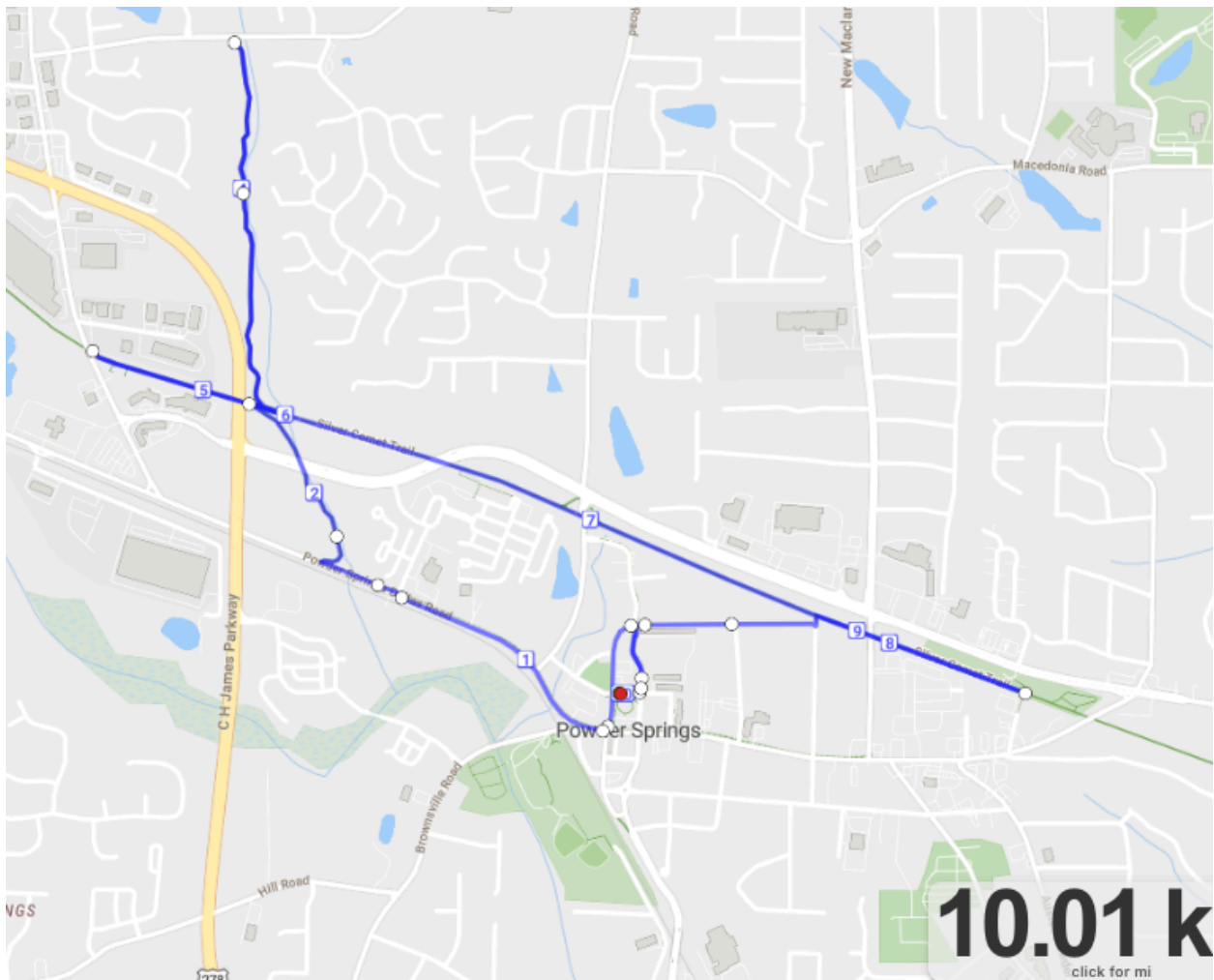
5k



This 5K minimizes traffic infringement by utilizing the Lucille trail and the Silver Comet Trail. As the runners leave the silver comet trail they will cross the street and utilize the new path extension taking them back to the town center.

The beginning of the race on the Powder Springs Dallas Road should only be on the road for approximately 5 to 7 minutes until they exit the road. To avoid the Brownsville Road intersection the course could be modified by going out to Lost Mountain before entering Powder Springs Dallas Road reducing the impact even further.

Optional 10K



The 10K is similar to the 5k course having the same Start / Finish and the additional length is made up utilizing more of the existing train system while maintaining low impact on the local traffic flow.
