## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022 – 091**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH COMMUNITIES IN SCHOOLS OF GEORGIA IN MARIETTA/COBB COUNTY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000.00 TO PERFORM TUTORING SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to help address the learning gap experienced by local students due to the pandemic which closed schools and disrupted normal education processes, and set aside funding from its American Rescue Plan Act grant for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City issued RFP 22-007 to solicit proposals from vendors with experience providing tutoring services for students who are unable to complete work at their expected grade level, and opened proposals on May 2, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Communities in Schools of Georgia in Marietta/Cobb County is a non-profit organization based in Cobb County with experience providing tutoring services and improving educational outcomes for struggling students, is capable of providing the services sought through RFP 22-004, and has proposed to perform these services at a cost of \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Selection Committee reviewed all of the proposals submitted in response to RFP 22-007 and believe that awarding the contract to Communities in Schools of Georgia in Marietta/Cobb County will accomplish the Mayor and Council's goals to help students who have fallen behind;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Communities in Schools of Georgia in Marietta/Cobb County in the amount of \$50,000.00 to perform tutoring services for students at two elementary schools in Powder Springs, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
