A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF THE FLOCK CAMERA SYSTEM FOR AN ADDITIONAL FIVE YEAR TERM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000 AND THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF TWO ADDITIONAL FLOCK CAMERAS FOR THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000 FOR USE BY PUBLIC SAFETY; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT TO EFFECTUATE SAME; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs previously approved the purchase and installation of a Flock Camera System for a three year term and the purchase of ten cameras, which has provided valuable assistance to the City's Criminal Investigations Division in its investigations;

WHEREAS, the Flock Camera System is willing to renew the system and provide two additional cameras at the original price of \$2,500 per camera in exchange for an agreement for five additional one year terms;

WHEREAS, the Flock Camera System is recommended for consistency of use by Cobb County and other cities in Cobb, and the City desires to renew the use of the system and to acquire two additional cameras in the interest of public health, safety and welfare for five one-year terms for a cost of \$30,000 instead of \$36,000.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes and approves the renewal of the Flock Camera System and the the purchase and installation of additional cameras for the amount of \$30,000.00, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
