A Village Called Home Inc.

Program Overview

A Village Called Home Inc. proposes the operation of a structured residential care program designed to provide a safe, stable, trauma-informed, and supervised residential environment for children requiring behavioral support, emotional stabilization, life-skills development, educational support, and structured supervision. The facility is intended to function as a family-style residential environment that prioritizes safety, accountability, emotional well-being, educational achievement, and positive behavioral development while maintaining compatibility with the surrounding residential community.

Anticipated Number & Ages of Children

The proposed residential program anticipates serving up to twelve (12) children within the approximate age range of seven (7) through seventeen (17) years old. Residents may include children requiring structured supervision, behavioral support, emotional stabilization, educational coordination, and life-skills assistance.

Staffing Plan & Licensing Requirements

The facility shall maintain awake staff supervision twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week. The facility shall maintain a minimum staffing ratio of one (1) staff member for every four (4) residents during waking hours. Staff positions may include Executive Director, Program Director, House Manager, Direct Care Staff, Behavioral Support Staff, Case Managers, Licensed Therapists, Contracted Medical Providers, and Overnight Awake Staff.

Educational Attendance & Public School Coordination

Residents shall attend designated public schools assigned according to applicable school district zoning and enrollment requirements unless otherwise approved through educational placement determinations or individualized education plans (IEPs).

Resident Supervision & Care Procedures

Residents shall remain under structured supervision at all times while participating in educational programming, recreational activities, meals, transportation, counseling services, life-skills programming, and community activities.

Emergency Preparedness & Safety

The facility shall maintain comprehensive emergency preparedness procedures including fire safety protocols, severe weather response procedures, evacuation procedures, medical emergency response procedures, first responder coordination protocols, and emergency communication procedures.

Primary Managing Caregiver & 24-Hour Contact Availability

The facility shall designate a primary managing caregiver and supervisory contact available by telephone on a twenty-four (24) hour basis to respond to emergencies, complaints, operational concerns, neighborhood concerns, or other issues requiring immediate response.
