

RESOLUTION 2025 - 029

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF 1500 SANITATION CARTS AT AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$87,325; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH TOTER TO EFFECTUATE THE PURCHASE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") in 2002 identified the need and thus requested and received quotes to initiate a replacement program of sanitation carts that are on average dated by more than twenty years; and

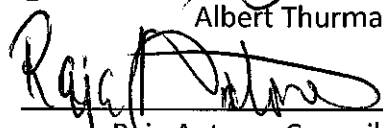
WHEREAS the City purchased the first 1500 replacement set in 2022, the second 1500 replacement set in 2023, the third 1500 replacement in 2024 and the fourth in 2025; and

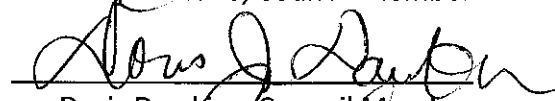
WHEREAS the solid waste and fleet services director recommend, and the City finds it in the public interest, to proceed with the fifth and final replacement by continuing with the same product supplied by Toter and thereafter transitioning to a typical order inventory.

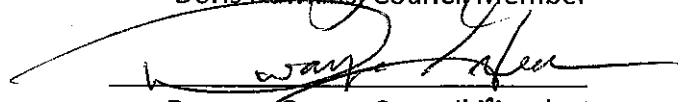
NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the bid of Toter for 1500 new sanitation carts for the fifth and final phase of the replacement program at an amount not to exceed \$87,325 is hereby accepted and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same after review and approval by the City Attorney.

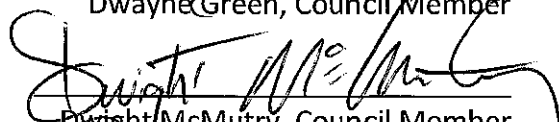

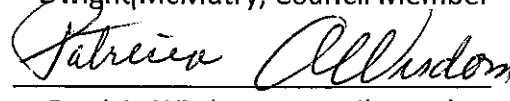

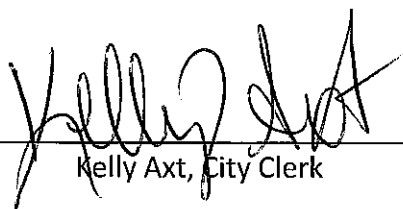
