AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE EQUITABLE SHARING ACCOUNT TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY BUDGET FOR THE PURCHASE OF HARD DRIVES FOR THE STORAGE OF VIDEOS; TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 RELATING TO BUILDING PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") previously authorized the purchase of hard drives in an amount not to exceed \$6,000 for the storage of videos taken from police department body cameras and vehicle cameras utilizing equitable sharing funds, and the City desires to amend the budget to allocate said funds to the police department budget;


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") has issued more building permits than programmed and budgeted thereby increasing permit fees received as well as expenses incurred by the building official, and the City desires to amend the budget to account for the increase in fees and expenses related to the increased issuance of building permits;




