A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A DEDUCTIVE CHANGE ORDER WITH DAF CONCRETE, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,968 AND CLOSE THE REPAIR PROJECT IN CAMERON SPRINGS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs previously engaged DAF Concrete, Inc. to complete repairs of damaged infrastructure of curbing, sidewalks and storm drain infrastructure within the Cameron Springs Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, said repairs have been completed at an amount \$30,968 less than bid and awarded, and the City desires to complete and close out the project and accept the deductive change order presented by DAF Concrete, Inc;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute a deductive change order with DAF Concrete, Inc. for an amount of \$30,968 and close the repair project located within the Cameron Springs Subdivision. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


