


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the “City”) facilities personnel became aware of a failed motor blower in the heating, ventilation and air control system at the Seven Springs Museum at the Bodiford House requiring immediate repair or replacement; and

WHEREAS, city personnel immediately solicited and authorized the proposal from the City’s HVAC contractor to replace the failed motor blower, and Mayor and Council find said work to be necessary, appropriate and in the best interest of the public to proceed immediately.


NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the replacement of the failed motor blower at a cost of \$1369 was immediately necessary and hereby approves and ratifies said action and the mayor’s signature executing an agreement with the City’s HVAC contractor.

SO RESOLVED AND EFFECTIVE this 2nd day of February 2026.




