

At the top of the driveway, which is usually wider as one needs space to enter/exit the vehicle, it would be 11 feet wide instead of 12 feet.

Only in that area at the top of the driveway directly across from existing concrete pad I would need the separation from the property line to be 4 feet.



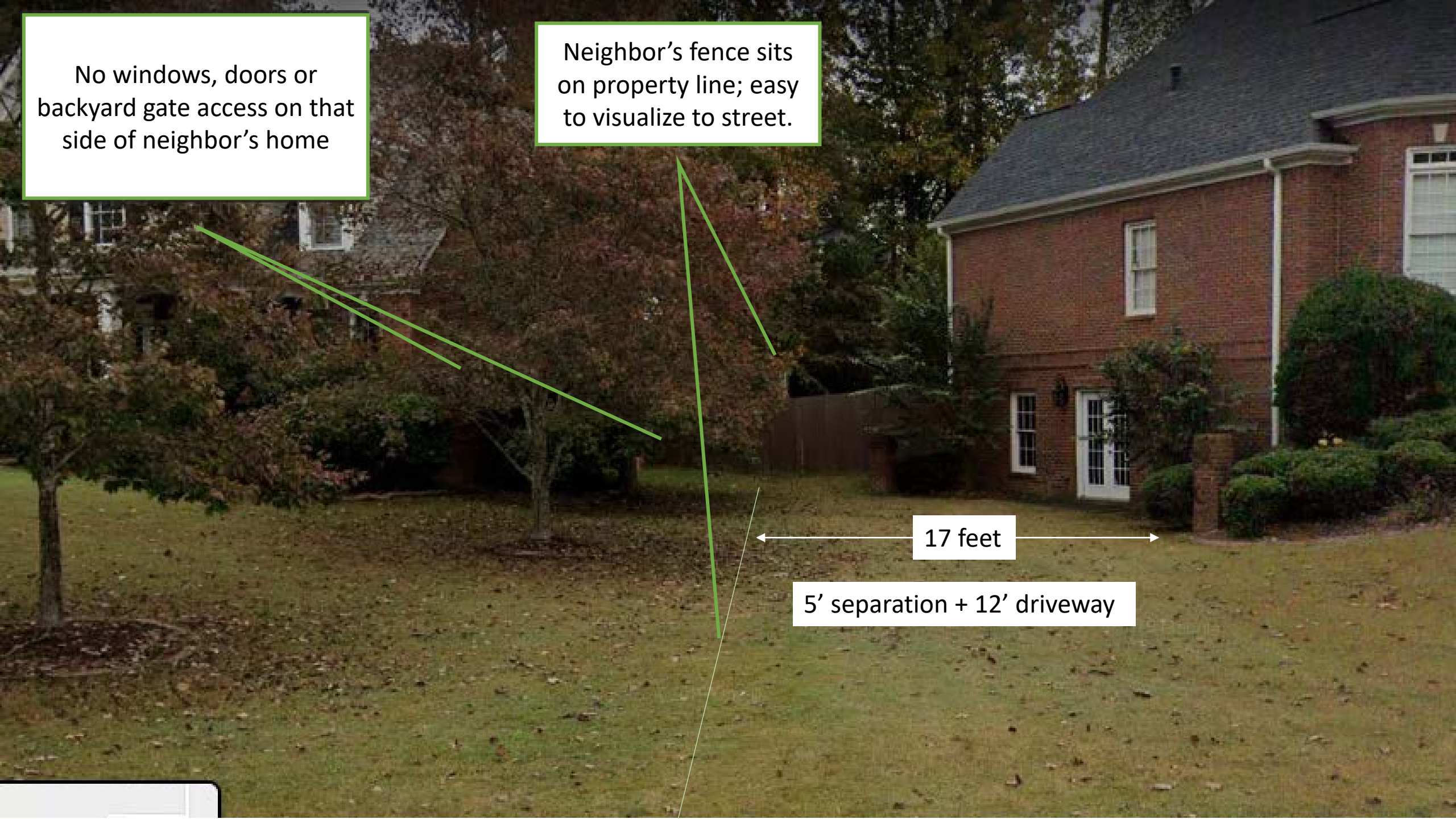
Only top portion is 1 foot tight. Top portion is where width is always needed.

White line indicates 5 feet from property line, but the driveway would only be 11 feet wide at that point at the top of the driveway where normally driveways are wider to accommodate vehicle entry/exit.

The handle of tape measure indicates the 12 foot width needed, which would be 4 feet from the property line.
