A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE PURCHASE OF HARD DRIVES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,000 FOR THE PROPER STORAGE OF VIDEOS TAKEN FROM POLICE DEPARTMENT BODY CAMERAS AND VEHICLE CAMERAS; AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PREPARE AND COMPLETE AN APPROPRIATE BUDGET AMENDMENT TO ALLOCATE EQUITABLE SHARING FUNDS TO THE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs Police Department (the "City Police") is required under the State of Georgia record retention laws to store videos taken from body and vehicle cameras but has insufficient storage capacity on its existing servers to meet the record retention requirements;

WHEREAS, the City Police previously received Federal Equitable Sharing Program funds and desires to use said funds to purchase hard drives for the proper storage of videos taken from police department body cameras and vehicle cameras, and the City of Powder Springs City Council desires to facilitate said purchase and authorize preparation of a budget amendment for the allocation of funds;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and approves the attached proposal submitted by VC3 for four configured Dell 6T cabled hard drives for an amount of up to \$6,000.00 and authorizes the Finance Director to prepare and complete an appropriate budget amendment to allocate said funds to the City Police budget;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the Mayor to execute any agreements required to complete the purchase of said equipment, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
