

RESOLUTION 2021 – 113

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SURPLUSING AND SALE OF FILE CABINETS WHICH ARE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OR OTHER MUNICIPAL PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs Community Department recently completed digitizing its paper zoning files and is now in possession of empty file cabinets, which are no longer needed for community development or other municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it in the best interest of the City to declare as surplus and dispose of said file cabinets;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council that it hereby declares as surplus and authorizes disposal in accordance with governing laws and regulations the file cabinets identified in the attached Exhibit A.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is authorized to execute any documentation necessary to effectuate the sale, disposal or auction of said property. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
