RESOA RESOLUTION DIRECTING AND CONFIRMING CERTAIN EQUAL ACCESS BY UNINCORPORATED AREA RESIDENTS TO CITY OWNED PARKS FACILITIES, RECREATION PROGRAMS, LIBRARIES AND SENIOR SERVICE FACILITIES; APPROVING AN EXTENSION OF THE CITY'S AGREEMENT WITH THE COMMUNICATIONS TEAM; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (the "City") previously approved and authorized the mayor to execute a service delivery strategy agreement with Cobb County (the "Agreement") and submit the Agreement and forms to the Georgia Department of Community Affairs for verification; and

WHEREAS the City also authorized its Special Council, in consultation with the Mayor, City Manager and City Attorney, to make non-substantive modifications to the Agreement that deal with the form of information conveyed, rather than the substance of how services will be provided or funded; and

WHEREAS the Agreement entitled unincorporated residents to full access to City-owned parks and recreation programs, any City-owned library and any City-owned senior service facility on equal terms as City residents in the municipal jurisdiction where the park and recreation program, library and senior facility is located; and

WHEREAS the City further authorized the mayor to execute a certain agreement with communication specialists to develop and implement a communications plan and finds it in the public interest to extend the agreement as it pertains to the City and implementation of the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes and confirms that unincorporated residents have full access to city-owned parks and recreational programs, library and senior service facility on equal terms as City residents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it authorizes a three-month extension of the agreement with the communications specialists as it pertains to the City for the monthly amount of \$2500 and until the Agreement has been verified by DCA and payment made to the city.
