AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 TO ROLL FORWARD THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS ALLOCATED TO OUTSTANDING PRIOR YEAR ENCUMBRANCES AND FOR EXPENDITURES OF CERTAIN FUNDS; TO ALLOCATE THE SOURCE OF REVENUE FOR SAID FUNDS; TO AMEND THE GENERAL FUND TO ALLOCATE EQUITABLE SHARING PROGRAM FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF A POLICE VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs have determined that circumstances warrant a change in the existing budget ordinance for fiscal year 2019 to roll forward prior year budget appropriations allocated to encumbrances outstanding at June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council previously authorized the purchase of police department vehicles using funds from the equitable sharing account and the special purpose local option sales tax ("SPLOST") program account pursuant to Resolution 18-081 and Ordinance 2018-020 but the accompanying exhibit to said ordinance only included the transfer for approved automatic equipment defibrillators and unintentionally omitted the transfer from the equitable sharing funds to the city police department budget for police vehicles and vehicle equipment;

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the fiscal year 2019 be amended as provided in the attached Schedule A and Schedule B;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon execution by the Mayor and City Council.
