AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 RELATING TO THE RECEIPT AND APPROPRIATION OF IMPACT FEES; TO TRANSFER COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ANNEXATION AND BUSINESS RETENTION SERVICE FEES TO THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
