
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF FOUR MOBILE AND ENCRYPTED IN-CAR RADIOS FROM MOTOROLA FOR AN AMOUNT OF UP TO \$28,000; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE CERTAIN AGREEMENTS TO EFFECTUATE SAID PURCHASE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") police department has identified a need to purchase four mobile and encrypted radios for install and use in police vehicles to bring its inventory count to 34 mobile (in car) radios; and


WHEREAS the City desires to authorize the purchase of said radios using savings in its capital budget resulting from reduced vehicle costs.


NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Police Chief is authorized to purchase four mobile and encrypted in-car radios from Motorola for an amount up to \$28,000.00, and the Mayor is authorized to execute agreements necessary to effectuate the purchase of said radios, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.




