A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR USE BY PUBLIC SAFETY TWELVE FLOCK CAMERAS AND CAMERA SYSTEM FOR FIVE ONE-YEAR TERMS FOR AN ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$30,000 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs previously approved the purchase and installation of a Flock Camera System and the purchase of twelve cameras, which has provided valuable assistance to the City's Criminal Investigations Division in its investigations; and

WHEREAS following the City's initial purchase of ten cameras, the City was offered, and it accepted the opportunity to purchase two additional cameras at the initial reduced price of \$2,500 per camera in in exchange for an agreement for five additional one-year terms; and

WHEREAS the contractor and city desire to consolidate previous approvals and all twelve cameras and system into one agreement to streamline invoicing.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes and approves an agreement to use and maintain twelve Flock cameras and system for five one-year terms for an annual amount of \$30,000.00, and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement to effectuate same, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
