Subject: Request for a Meeting to Present Ideas for Festival at the Grand Opening of the New City Park and Amphitheater

Dear Mr. Crowder:

The purpose of this letter is to request the opportunity to meet with yourself and City of Powder Spring dignitaries, to discuss my offer to develop, promote, and manage a two-day festival for the grand opening of the new city park and amphitheater at a very small cost to the City. In our previous discussions, we discussed the potential for an annual festival that would include a juried arts and crafts show and artisan demonstrations; professionally produced live music of several genres; a wide variety of quality food vendors and food trucks; a kids area; wine and beer gardens featuring "local" products, hard ciders, and national/regional brands; silent auctions to benefit the Kids Camp Program; and a reception for the opening of the park for up to 30 dignitaries. The only costs to the City would be security provided by the City of Powder Springs Police Department or someone of their choosing for Friday and Saturday nights (approximately 24 hours total), and about \$100 for the liquor license to enable beer and wine sales.

During an open meeting, I will present a plan to achieve a successful grand opening and pave the way for future reoccurring two-day events at the same time each year. Specific topics would include developing and capitalizing on sponsorships and community assets; utilizing multiple avenues for publicizing the festival; and recognizing the City and County resources that would be necessary to support the event such as Facebook, email blasts etc. My goal is to involve community and community officials in creating a plan that will promote tourism and development for Powder Springs. I will aggressively target audiences with the highest quality of materials and methods in advertising; and create a website to highlight sponsors in the two-day event.

I currently promote three annual highly juried arts and fine crafts shows at Brasstown Valley Resort and Spa, including the Sweetheart Show, the Mother's Day show, and a top 20 nominated Southeast Tourism Board Holiday Show for the past 10 years. The cost to the Brasstown Resort is zero; their support is done by Facebook, email blasts, and adding the events to their website. These events have brought in profits for food and beverage, and lodging. I promote the North Georgia Highlands Seafood and Wine Festival, which has been awarded a Southeast Tourism Board Top 20 Award in its third year. This festival also provides a silent auction where 100% of the proceeds go to the County Food Pantry. I have promoted the Helen Alpine Village Show in Helen, Georgia, for the past eight years. The cost to the City is zero; however, I am charged for signage and event permits annually after approval by the City Council. The City of Helen does provide Facebook, and advertisement of the event on the Welcome and Convention Center website. I pride myself on promoting highly successful shows within the means of Robin Roberts Promotions, community involvement and sponsorships.

I would be glad to make a multi-media presentation at any time suitable for yourself and City of Powder Springs officials to discuss the potential for a festival for the City Park grand opening. I would prepare a PowerPoint presentation that would include the topics above, and would welcome any questions prior to the meeting that you or the officials would like me to address.

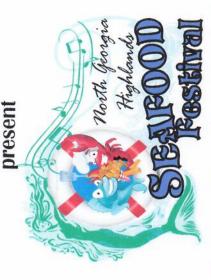
