
**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY USE AND CLOSURE OF THURMAN SPRINGS PARK AND SURROUNDING ROADS ON OCTOBER 26, 2024 FROM 9AM TO 4PM TO ACCOMMODATE A TEMPORARY EVENT HOSTED BY LINKEDUP CHURCH; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


**WHEREAS** the City of Powder Springs (“City”) has received an application for temporary event permit from LinkedUp Church to host Blocktoberfest at Thurman Springs Park on October 26, 2024 from 9AM to 4PM that will require the temporary use and closure the park and certain roads around the park; and


**WHEREAS** the City finds it in the public interest to authorize the use and closure of certain public spaces in the downtown to accommodate Blocktoberfest and further its strategic priorities of creating an atmosphere of community and creating destinations that appeal to residents and visitors.


