

Resolution No. 2025 - 116

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH A RELOCATION COMPANY TO PROVIDE SUPPLIES AND LABOR FOR PACKING OF MATERIALS AND FOR MOVING FROM TEMPORARY LOCATIONS TO THE NEW CITY HALL AND STORAGE FACILITY FOR AN AMOUNT OF UP TO \$20,000; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (the "City") will relocate certain City offices to the new city hall and storage for later surplus; and

WHEREAS the City will solicit and obtain quotes for said moving services, scheduled to occur early August, during which time the affected services will be unavailable; and

WHEREAS the City budgeted up to \$20,000 to cover the cost of relocation and desires to approve moving expenditures.

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement for supplies and labor for moving from temporary locations to the new city hall and storage for a cost up to the approved budgeted amount of \$20,000 subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
