

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-016

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A TEMPORARY RECREATION EVENT PERMIT FOR THE TYLER GREENE & TAYLOR GRANT FOUNDATION 5K RUN/WALK IN MEMORY OF TYLER GREENE AT THE WILDHORSE TRAIL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Tyler Greene & Taylor Grant Foundation (“the Foundation”) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization benefitting area youth by increasing educational opportunities through scholarships, raising awareness regarding water safety, and assisting those who want to learn how to swim; and

WHEREAS, the Foundation has applied for and wishes to conduct a 5K Run/Walk in memory of Tyler Greene at the Wildhorse Trail on Saturday, September 12th from 6:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. which will entail temporary closures of Hopkins Road to allow participants to cross safely; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs find the application of the Foundation to meet the necessary criteria and wish to grant the requested permit, provided that the Foundation secure a minimum of one police officer to conduct traffic control on Hopkins Road to allow run/walk participants to cross safely.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the application of the Tyler Greene & Taylor Grant Foundation to conduct a 5K Run/Walk in memory of Tyler Greene at the Wildhorse Trail on Saturday, September 12th from 6:30 a.m. until 11:30 is hereby approved on the condition that the Foundation secure a minimum of one police officer to conduct traffic control on Hopkins Road to allow run/walk participants to safely cross. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
