

RESOLUTION 2021-200

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH WAYNE WRIGHT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BY A SUBCONTRACTOR RISK MANAGER TO PREPARE AND REAPPLY FOR CERTIFICATION FOR THE CITY'S POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$20,340; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs previously approved an agreement with Wayne Wright for professional services related to the management and implementation of the American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") program; and

WHEREAS, Wayne Wright has a subconsultant risk manager with experience and availability to prepare and reapply for state certification for the City's police department in 2022; and


WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the agreement to enable the risk manager to proceed with preparing and reapplying for state certification for the City's police department in 2022;

BE IT THEREFOR RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an amendment to the agreement with Wayne Wright to engage the services of his subconsultant risk manager to prepare and reapply for state certification for the police department for a sum of \$20,340, subject to review and approval of the City Attorney.


