A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE ANNUAL SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT WITH THE COBB COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM OFFICE FOR THE USE OF CDBG FUNDS FOR PUBLIC FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2026; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

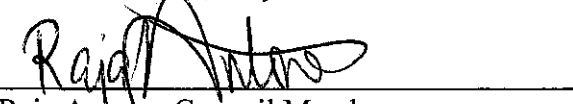
WHEREAS Cobb County receives Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 to carry out various community development activities in unincorporated areas and in municipalities participating in the CDBG program, including the City of Powder Springs (the "City");

WHEREAS the City receives an annual fair share amount from the CDBG program and desires to approve and authorize its Program Year 2026 allocation to complete certain public facility and infrastructure improvements to include repairs needed for compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and improvements needed to public facilities at the Ford Center campus to accommodate use by senior citizens and senior citizen programming and to execute the Program Year 2026 Subrecipient Agreement;

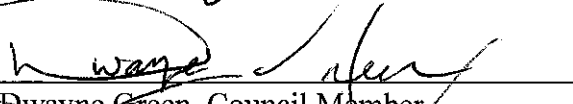

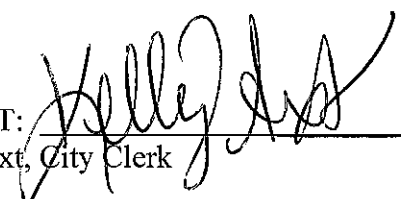
