

RESOLUTION 2021 – 133

A RESOLUTION ABANDONING A SECTION OF THE MUNICIPAL STREET SYSTEM BEING KNOWN AS LINDLEY LANE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (“the City”) owns and maintains a municipal street system; and

WHEREAS, the City did previously maintain a municipal street known as Lindley Lane, having a thirty (30) foot right-of-way, which provided a connection between Hotel Avenue and Atlanta Street; and

WHEREAS, roadway improvements as part of the City’s Lewis Road project rendered Lindley Lane obsolete and no longer in use; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of The Official Code of Georgia Annotated § 32-7-2 (c), when the City determines that a section of the municipal street system has for any reason ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it or that its removal from the municipal street system is otherwise in the best public interest, the City, by certification recorded in its minutes, accompanied by a plat or sketch, and after notice to property owners located thereon, may declare that section of the municipal street system abandoned; and

WHEREAS, Lindley Lane has ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it and its removal from the municipal street system is in the best public interest; and

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed abandonment has been provided to the property owners located thereon.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that Lindley Lane has ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it, its removal from the municipal street system is in the best public interest, and it is hereby declared abandoned. Expressly excluded from abandonment is any portion of the former Lindley Lane currently lying in the right of way of another municipal street. This Resolution shall serve as the required Certification of Abandonment with a sketch of the abandoned area attached hereto and incorporated herein by way of reference as Exhibit “A” to be recorded in the City’s official minutes. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


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
