

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-156

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH COBB COUNTY RELATING TO THE UPGRADES TO THE 800 MHz RADIO SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") has an existing agreement with Cobb County for the maintenance and upgrade of the 800 MHz Radio System;

WHEREAS, Cobb County intends to enter into a System Upgrade with Motorola Solutions (the "Agreement") and provide the City the City's pro-rata share for the upgrades, which will be due by September 30th of each year beginning in 2018;

WHEREAS, the Agreement will provide regularly scheduled system updates, software refreshers and any additional hardware necessitated by said upgrades, with guaranteed and budgetable pricing and accordingly is less expensive and will keep the radio system current with small incremental upgrades as well as reduce the costs associated with the core replacement at the end of the Agreement term;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and authorizes the Mayor to execute an amendment to its existing license agreement with Cobb County for regular incremental upgrades of the MHz Radio System, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.




