A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR PROJECTS IDENTIFIED BY THE CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS IN ITS LIVABLE CENTERS INITATIVE PLAN, SPECIAL PURPOSE LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX PROGRAM OR ITS COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, from time to time, various agencies and organizations, including the Atlanta Regional Commission, will solicit applications for funding assistance for qualifying projects, and the City of Powder Springs desires to apply for funding assistance for its projects identified, recommended and programmed in its approved and adopted Livable Centers Initiative ("LCI") plan, the Special Purpose Local Options Sales Tax ("SPLOST") program or its Comprehensive Plan ("CP);

WHEREAS, said funding solicitations impose a local funding match, and the City desires to provide said match through the SPLOST program or its approved capital budget;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Powder Springs, Georgia, that the City Council supports the City of Powder Springs applications for funding assistance in response to solicitations for applications for projects identified, recommended and programmed in its approved and adopted LCI plan, SPLOST program or its Comprehensive Plan and provide the required 20% match and administer the project should grant funds be awarded. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
