A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CROY ENGINEERING FOR THE DESIGN, ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION OVERSIGHT OF A WATER LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT ON SHARON DRIVE FROM GERALDING STREET TO PARKS DRIVE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") Public Works Department has experienced ongoing water line problems on Sharon Drive from Geralding Street to Parks Drive and has determined that approximately 2200 feet of existing six AC/Cast Iron 6 inch water line should be replaced with a 6 inch Ductile Iron water line to include the installation of additional water valve locations for future maintenance;

WHEREAS, proposals were solicited and obtained, and the City desires to accept the proposal submitted by Croy Engineering as the lowest most responsive proposal to.

WHEREAS, all work will be in compliance with AWWA standards, City of Powder Springs ordinances, Cobb County-Marietta Water Authority, Clean Water Act, Environmental Protection Agency (to include proper removal of asbestos pipe) and the Georgia Environmental Protection Division requirements, federal regulations and state laws.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Croy Engineering for an amount not to exceed \$57,000, to generate project design plans, generate project bid documents for construction, let the project to construction and perform construction management services for oversight of the water line replacement project on Sharon Drive, as described in its proposal and in the City's solicitation, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
